



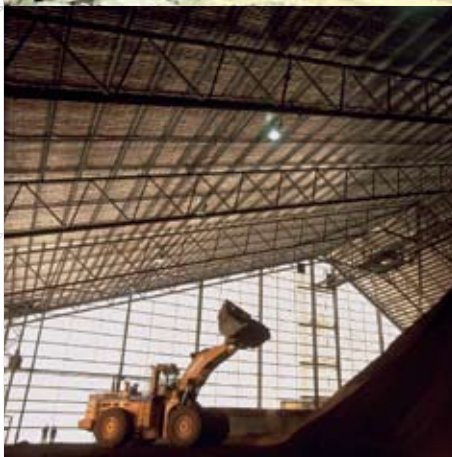

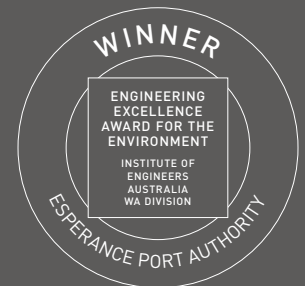


KCL was awarded in January 2001 a Lump Sum Contract to design and construct Port Upgrade Facilities for the storage and handling of iron ore. KCL have now constructed 4 similar storage facilities for the EPA over the past seven years, after competitive tender.

This project includes: 300,000 tonne sealed stockpile building (approx. 270m long x 80m wide) including a complex dust collection system throughout the building.

4,000 tph fully enclosed inloading / outloading gallery conveyors 2.0 km in length integrated into existing facilities and new Ship Loader.

This project was completed 1 month ahead of the Client's Schedule and received five industry awards which included the Institute of Engineers Australia WA Division 2002 Engineering Excellence Award for the Environment and the 2002 AISC WA Steel Awards - Steel Construction Award.
